1	Paper bag craft	Up to 6 different items For example: Pipe cleaners Tinsel Straws Felt Wool Googly eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using a paper bag to make a craft creation. • Can have up to 6 different items from home to glue on or add to their creation for decoration • Can have as much of one item as needed. • Can bring a picture for inspiration to help them put together their creation. • Creation will be made at school. • We will provide the paper bag, paint, sellotape, glue • Painting will be done the day before at school, if needed. • Please note that nothing can be pre cut, drawn or stuck together at home. All cutting, sticking etc must be done by the children in class.

Paper plate ideas • Can have up to 6 different items from home to glue on or add to their creation for decoration • Can have as much of one item as needed. • Can bring a picture for inspiration to help them put together their creation. • Creation will be made at school. • We will provide the paper bag, paint, sellotape, glue • Painting will be done the day before at school, if needed. • Please note that nothing can be pre cut, drawn or stuck together at home. Room 3	Milk bottle creation	<p>Equipment needed * Must be a clean, washed 2L milk bottle * Craft materials to decorate (Glue and paint will be provided)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No preparation to be done before • Creation must be made at school. • Cutting & painting will be done the day before at school, if needed. • Creation need to be no higher than 50 cm and no wider than 50cm • Can bring a picture for inspiration to help them put together their creation. • Please note that nothing can be pre cut, drawn or stuck together at home. All drawing, cutting, sticking etc must be done by the children in class
4	Miniature Garden Scene	<p>Equipment needed: Standard size tray/roasting dish.</p> <p>Natural materials collected from home e.g. foliage, rocks, flowers, sticks, etc. Think carefully when choosing foliage, young growth will wilt.</p> <p>Optional Equipment- No more than 4 man-made items (e.g. Lego figures, plastic animals, craft materials etc.)</p> <p>School will supply the sand.</p>	<p>Using a standard sized roasting dish, students will create a miniature garden scene. This could be their favourite place, their favourite thing to do, farm life, etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Creation must be made at school. • Can bring a picture for inspiration to help them put together their creation. • No more than 4 man-made objects. • Creation will be contained within the tray. • No limit on natural objects/materials but sometimes less is best. • This creation will be made in class on the day of the Hall of Creativity. Materials will be collected at home and brought in on the day.
5	Clay - small bowl or trinket dish	<p>Equipment needed: - clay and tools will be provided by the school. Optional - Children may like to bring up to 3 different items to press into their design.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Small stones • Mosaic tiles • Beads • Flowers • Leaves • Items to create texture in the clay. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students will make their item on Monday before calf day in order to dry and harden. - Children will be given 200g of clay each to work with. - Children can paint or glaze their creation on the morning of judging if they wish.

All children will create their exhibit at school during the morning of the 16th October, ready for judging that afternoon. To avoid children being penalised please make sure they carefully follow the guidelines.
